Beasley Coliseum was constructed in 1973.

The 193,000 SF coliseum is in need of acoustical improvements, interior spatial reorganization, and minor additions to enhance the quality and the versatility of the facility as a host for university events like commencement, performing and other cultural events.

As the main performance venue for the Pullman Campus and the Community, the 30+ year old facility needs serious acoustical upgrades to maintain the quality experienced in the past and to continue to encourage a wide range of performance opportunities.
